- -The Pre-wrath Rapture proponents wrongly interpret Revelation 6:17.
- The phrase "is come" is translated from an aorist active indicative verb in the Greek. In modern English we could say, "is here," meaning that they were experiencing it already.

III. The Nature

-"Rapture" comes from the Latin meaning "" or "snatch up" and "catch away." - The Greek equivalent is found in 1 Thessalonians 4:17 and is
translated "caught up."
The Rapture is an imminent event.
- Imminent – from Latin meaning or hanging over your head.
- Our salvation is "ready to be revealed in the last time." (1 Peter 1:5).
There are no signs preceding the Rapture.
James 5:7–9
- The verb phrases "draweth nigh" and "standeth before the door" are
translated from Greek words that are in the perfect tense and
indicative mood speaking of an action completed in the past with
ongoing results. In other words, His coming was near, and it still is.
Revelation 22:7, 12 "Behold, I come quickly (, not soon)."
- The immanency of the Rapture is a purifying and motivating doctrine. 1 John 3:3 says that "Every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself."

- "The Lord himself shall descend from heaven . . ." (1 Thess. 4:16)
- Titus 2:13, "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ."
- General Douglas MacArthur said, "I shall return," and he did.
- Jesus said, "I will come again," and He will. Will we be ready?
